**Pointwise estimates on derivatives of
Coulombic wavefunctions**

Prof. Thomas Østergaard Sørensen (LMU)

ABSTRACT: In this talk we prove (optimal) a priori pointwise bounds for all derivatives of non-relativistic Coulombic eigenfunctions, involving negative powers of the distance to the singularities of the many-body potential. If time permits, we discuss consequences for the corresponding electron density.
