

Gradings and Decomposition Numbers – useful information for the workshop -

1. Local transport

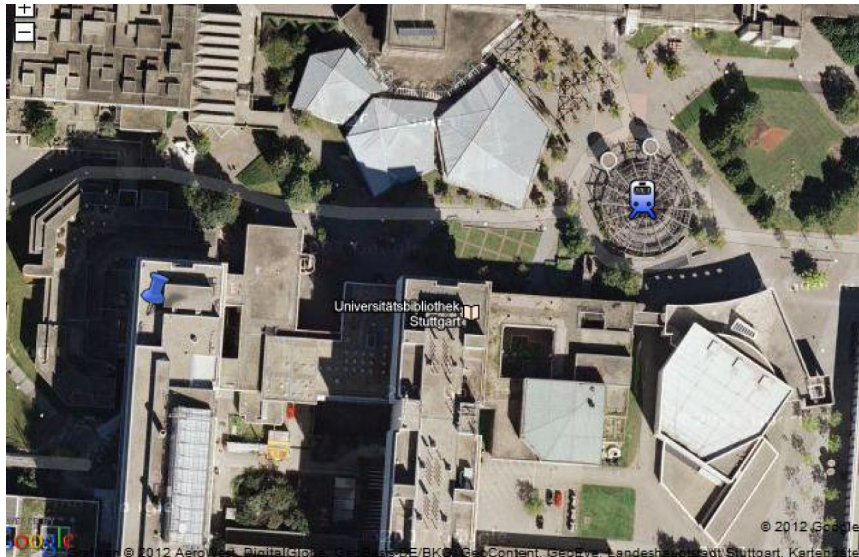
How to get to the workshop from the city or airport

- The workshop takes place in building Pfaffenwaldring 57 of the University Campus Vaihingen (see blue pin on the map below) in room V57.02.
- *Coming from the city:* At the central station “Hauptbahnhof” follow the subway (S-Bahn) signs



and take S-Bahn S1 to Herrenberg, S2 or S3 to Flughafen, Vaihingen or Filderstadt and get off at “Universität”. Exit the subway in the opposite direction of travel.

- *Coming from the airport (Flughafen):* Take the subways (S-Bahn) S2 to Schorndorf or S3 to Backnang and get off at the station “Universität”. Exit the subway in the direction of travel.



Buy your ticket from a vending machine before boarding the train. There are cheaper tickets for four rides, to be stamped at the entrance of the station before boarding the train, and for one or three days. For more details please consult the attached information sheet of the local transport association (VVS).

How to get to the city centre, Hauptbahnhof or airport

- The city centre or the Hauptbahnhof (central railway station) can be reached from the University Campus in 10 minutes by the subways (S-Bahn) S1, S2 or S3 in the directions of Kirchheim, Schorndorf or Backnang respectively.
- The airport can be reached by the subways S2 or S3 in the opposite direction (i.e. Flughafen/Vaihingen/Filderstadt).

How to get to the workshop from the hotels

- *Römerhof*: This is located a 20 minutes walk away from our institute. Just follow the road in the direction of the university and you should be able to spot two big towers on the left side of the road. Our building, Pfaffenwaldring 57, is one of them. Alternatively you can get the bus number 82 going from Johannesgraben bus stop, direction Waldeck. The University bus stop is two stops away from departure.
- *International Student Hotel*: This is located in the city centre, near the Schlossgarten. It is about 15 minutes walking distance from the main station (Hauptbahnhof). Alternatively, take the U-Bahn U9 or U14 from Stöckach, direction Vogelsang/Botnang and Heslach respectively to the Hauptbahnhof. There follow the directional signs to the S-Bahn platform and take S1, S2 or S3 in the direction of Herrenberg, Flughafen, Vaihingen or Filderstadt until the Universität station.
- *IB Hotel am Wallgraben*: This is located in Vaihingen. It is about 10 minutes walking distance from the station Vaihingen. There follow the directional signs to the S-Bahn platform and take S1, S2 or S3 in the direction of Kirchheim (Teck), Plochingen, Schorndorf or Backnang until the Universität station.
- *Gastdozentenhaus*: The workshop is on the other side of the street in one of the two big towers.

Where in Pfaffenwaldring 57 does the workshop take place?

- All talks take place in room V57.02 on the 1st floor of Pfaffenwaldring 57.
- There will be a reception in room 7.531 on the 7th floor of Pfaffenwaldring 57, Campus Vaihingen on Monday, September 24 starting at 12:30 pm.

From the university:

1. Take a train towards the city centre (S1 Kirchheim, S2 Schorndorf, S3 Backnang) and get off at the stop 'Stadtmitte'.
2. Head towards the exit of the train station towards the front of the train (in the direction of travel) and take the escalators up.
3. At the top of the escalators turn right and keep going (you will leave the train station).
4. After 50 meters or so, turn right into Calwer Strasse and keep going for further 150 meters.
5. The restaurant is on the left shortly after Starbucks.
